- 1. All registrants should read carefully the requirements as set out on the application form.
- 2. All Forms must be completed and signed by the individual legally authorized to do so.
- 3. ALL registrants must present where applicable the following valid documents, as proof of eligibility for registration:
 - a. Barbados Identification Card or Barbados Driver's License or Passport
 - b. VAT Registration Certificate or Letter
 - c. Tax Identification Number (TIN) Letter
 - d. Certificate of Incorporation/
 - e. Registration of Business Name Letter
