Re: Migration of ASYCUDA++ to ASYCUDA World

Proposed arrangements for the migration of Customs warehouse operations from ASYCUDA++ to ASYCUDA World.

1. All warehouse operators (In Bond and private bonded warehouses) must provide stock on hand as of August 24th 2019. The said report should be submitted to the Comptroller of Customs no later than Monday 26th August 2019. The declaration of stock on hand must be presented on a worksheet e.g. (MS Excel) clearly identifying the Customs warehouse code and must include but not limited to the following details:

- a) Stock Location (which outlet)
- b) Product Specification Code as declared on IM 7 declaration
- c) Product ID on inventory system/Point of Sale database
- d) Commercial description of product
- e) Retail Unit quantity
- f) Customs Value (item)
- g) Tariff Commodity Codes
- h) Country of Origin

2. The Customs administration will provide all warehouse operators with their respective ASYCUDA++ stock report as of 24th August 2019. The report will be provided immediately upon receipt of the corresponding stock report requested at 1 above.

3. All warehouse operators must bring to account all outstanding sales of warehoused goods by August 23rd 2019 and must pay the duties assessed on all unpaid ex-warehouse declarations by 26th August 2019. Thereafter, all warehousing transactions will be suspended until September 1st when ASYCUDA World becomes available.

4. The Customs administration will implement temporary measures to facilitate clearance of cargo for warehousing during the period of August 24th – September 1st 2019. All transactions processed under such measures must be finalized on AW no later than September 6th 2019.

5. The Customs administration will assist warehouse operators with preparing Warehousing Entries in XML format no later than August 30th 2019. The said warehouse declarations may be verified by the warehouse operator before submitting as a formal declaration of opening stock on ASYCUDA World.

6. Where a warehouse operator is in disagreement with any material content of the warehousing entries for item 5 above, the matter must be brought to the attention of the Comptroller and all warehouse operations must cease until the said matter is amicably resolved.

7. The Customs administration reserves the right to temporarily cease all warehouse operations of a non-compliant operator until the requirements at 1, 2, 3 and 5 are met.
